### From the Principals Pen...

This week we kicked off our first onsite transition session for our 2023 Foundation Students. Transition by definition is 'the process or a period of changing from one state or condition to another.' Children experience many transitions in their educational journey and as educators, we aim to make this movement from one step to the next as positive and engaging as possible. Providing opportunities for students to trial new routines and structures allows them to build confidence and connection to the new setting while saying goodbye to the old.

Our F2023 students were presented with 'F2023' t-shirts yesterday – allowing them to identify with our school and create a sense of belonging. These students will visit for increasingly longer periods of time over the coming weeks, culminating in a full day at 'Big School' on the State-wide transition day on Tuesday 13th December.

This day will be a big day of transition for all of our students! Our current grade 6 boys will set off to Tallangatta Secondary for their transition days over the Tuesday and Wednesday. These days will allow the boys to reconnect with Cluster friends met at Cluster Days and previous grade 6 transition days, navigate a new environment, meet new teachers and understand the structure and routine of High School.

Also on the State-wide transition day, current grade 2 students who will move to Millewa next year will spend the whole day with me in their 2023 classroom. This acknowledges the big step the transition from grade 2 to grade 3 is and supports students to feel comfortable in their new space, with new classmates before the end of term to alleviate any feelings of apprehension so that they have a positive perception of the year ahead.

For students with additional needs, supports are put into place to further enhance these transitions – please do not hesitate to contact me if you wish to discuss concerns regarding your child/ren's transition into 2023.



You are a very good teacher because you play very fun games with us. Ollie








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# Bethanga CFA Come & Try Day

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
